**26 [APPLICATION FOR A STREET TRADING CONSENT –

Having declared a personal and prejudicial interest, Councillor B Gibb-Gray withdrew from the meeting for consideration of this matter. In accordance with the Code of Conduct for Members Councillor Gibb-Gray exercised his right to make a representation to the Committee objecting to the application.

The Committee also received a deputation from Mr Cairns in support of his application

The Committee was asked to consider a report from the Business Development Team Leader concerning an application for a street trading consent to sell locally caught fish and cooked shellfish on the Emsworth Promenade. The application had been referred to the Committee in view of an objection that had been received.

Mr Cairns had applied for consent to sell locally caught fish and cooked shellfish however, in view of concerns raised by local businesses, he now offered to limit his trade to cooked shellfish only.

The meeting adjourned at 5.25pm and resumed at 5.30pm

RESOLVED that

- (1) Mr J Cairns' be granted consent to sell cooked shellfish only on the Emsworth Promenade, just to the North of the footbridge, from a hand cart and
- (2) consent be given subject to the conditions set out in paragraph 3.4 of the report, subject to an amendment removing the words "local caught fish and".

27 REVIEW OF CURRENT HACKNEY CARRIAGE FARES

The Committee considered a report from the Licensing Officer regarding the current Hackney Carriage fares requested by the Committee on 29 July 2008 (Minute 28(3) refers).
